## 2012 SUPER SUMMER ARKANSAS COVENANT FOR GROWTH

Because of my desire for growth and maturity in Christ through the opportunity of Super Summer, I stand in agreement and will submit to the following guidelines. I fully understand that the violation of these will result in my immediate return home at my own expense!

1. Students must dress appropriately and with Christian modesty in mind. Appropriate shorts will be permitted all day. Jeans are fine to wear in the evening. No sleeveless clothing and no tight fitting apparel (i.e. tight dresses, mini-skirts, gym shorts, etc.) is permitted at any time. No clothing will be permitted that exposes your midriff area or promotes rock groups, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, or suggestive messages.
2. Girls must wear one-piece swim suits.
3. Attendance at all meetings and participation in team recreation is required for everyone.
4. Participants must not use personal vehicles for any reason, or leave campus without first contacting the Super Summer Administrative Office.
5. Students are not allowed off campus. No student is allowed to leave the campus at any time. You cannot go off campus with your pastor, youth minister, or youth leader. Once the student is registered, they may not leave campus until check-out.
6. Scheduled times for room checks and curfew must be obeyed without exception.
7. During Super Summer, participants must submit to the direction and supervision of our Super Summer Staff, especially those assigned to your particular housing area.
8. Fireworks, firearms, knives or any other kind of weapon, alcohol, drugs, or any form of tobacco are NOT allowed. These items can be destructive to you and those around you. Also, DO NOT BRING skateboards, water guns, radios(including clock radios), video games, laser pointers, MP3 players, iPods, CD players, DVD players, pagers, or televisions. Also not allowed is any type of paint which can or will be applied to anything.
9. Any form of Public Displays of Affection (PDA) is not allowed. This is a week to work on your relationship with God.
10. Participants must wear name tags at all times. There will be a replacement fee if lost.
11. Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden. In fairness to everyone, we will eat in the campus cafeteria. Snacks brought from home should be in tightly sealed containers.
12. Cell phones are not allowed in classrooms or worship services. In order for cell phones to not be a distraction; students are encouraged to leave their cell phones at home.
13. OBU dorms are to be treated with respect. *Any damage will be charged to all students lodging in that room.* The university has allowed us to stay in their nice new dorms so let's help keep them that way!!!

I understand that these guidelines are necessary for me to maximize the spiritual opportunities of the week. Having read them I willingly commit myself to abide by them.
